### Teacher's notes

*Teacher: This exercise has several objectives. One, certainly will demonstrate the need for rules. As your students enter college or the workplace, they will find themselves bombarded with all manner of pressures to kick over the traces and ignore their heritage. If nothing else, this exercise will demonstrate that these pressures are not new.*

*Another objective will have the students experience the difficulty of writing and agreeing upon a common set of rules. Coming to agreement on a set of twelve rules may prove quite unattainable, and the lack of agreement should not constitute a failure, but a learning experience. Hand out copies of page 10-20, and ask the students to come to class prepared to establish their rules. If time does not permit to review the rules in class, suggest they debate the rules over lunch.*

*Lastly, the exercise will act as a form of review for several concepts of Cognitive Evaluation and Communication.*
